Thank you for your interest in having Sound Actuarial Consulting provide an actuarial review of the District's self-insured workers compensation program with a June 30, 2015 evaluation date. The actuarial study would include the following:

- 1. An analysis of the liabilities from existing workers compensation claims based on data evaluated as of June 30, 2015.
- 2. Preparation of exhibits for compliance with Governmental Accounting Standards Board Statement No. 10 (GASB 10) for your District's June 30, 2015 financial statements.
- 3. Derivation of projected costs for operating the self-insurance plan for fund year 2015 (July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016). These costs reflect the projected ultimate benefit and related expenses of all accidents expected to occur during the 12 month period beginning July 1, 2015. For the same fund year, Sound LLC will estimate the premium that the District would pay if it purchased insurance in the traditional market. MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is between Hofstra University (hereafter "Hofstra"), an independent non-profit educational institution, and Levittown Union Free School District (hereafter "Levittown"), an independent, public school district. Hofstra seeks to have its students obtain participant-observation and student teaching experience and fulfill academic and state teaching requirements by placing them with Levittown teachers, and Levittown recognizes the need for and desires to aid in the educational development of Hofstra students in exchange for Hofstra tuition certificates vouchers (hereafter "vouchers"). Hofstra and Levittown agree to participate in **two programs**: one in which Hofstra students are placed in Levittown classrooms to observe teaching, and the other in which participating Levittown teachers will mentor Hofstra student-teachers and undergraduate participant-observers seeking certification in Early Childhood/ Childhood, Secondary, and K-12 content (e.g. English 7-12 or Music 7-12) education.

- Hofstra and Levittown will mutually agree upon a specified number of Hofstra education students who are fulfilling student teaching or participantobservation requirements per academic semester. Hofstra students will be placed with Levittown's classroom teachers who have at least three years experience as certified teachers.
- 2. Participating teachers who supervise and mentor student teachers will receive a 1.5 credit Tuition Certificate Voucher for each student teacher they mentor. The voucher will be issued directly to the participating teacher through the hosting school to be used for continuing professional development through the Hofstra Office of Field Services or for enrollment in graduate courses at Hofstra. Hofstra will issue a list of events and activities that the Office of Professional Development Services will offer and the amount of credit vouchers required.
- 3. Participating teachers who supervise and mentor undergraduate 90-hour participant-observers seeking certification in Early Childhood and Childhood Education or 50-hour participant-observers seeking certification in secondary and K-12 content areas will receive a 1 credit voucher for each 90-hour or 50-hour participant-observer they mentor. The voucher will be issued to the participating teacher through the hosting school to be used for the participating teacher's continuing professional development through the Hofstra Office of Field Services or for enrollment in graduate courses at Hofstra. Hofstra will issue a list of events and activities that the Office of Field Services will offer and the amount of credit vouchers required.
- 4. In addition, Hofstra will give a 1-credit **Tuition Certificate Voucher** for every 250 hours that Hofstra **graduate elementary participant-observers** are placed in Levittown elementary classrooms to observe teachers or **graduate**

and undergraduate secondary education certification participantobservers or K-12 participant observers seeking K-12 teaching certification are placed in Levittown secondary level classrooms to observe teachers.

- 4. If Levittown or participating teacher plans to transfer the voucher, all information under the *Transfer Option* portion of the voucher is required, including the appropriate authorization. If the certificate *Transfer Option* portion is not completed, the voucher will not be honored. No vouchers may be issued or transferred to employees of Hofstra University.
- 6. Vouchers may not be used for independent studies, School of Law, Continuing Education, or thesis courses at Hofstra. Hofstra reserves the right to apply additional exclusions, at the sole discretion of Hofstra. All other terms listed on the voucher apply.
- 7. Vouchers must be presented to the Office of Student Accounts no later than the initial payment deadline for the semester in which the student intends to redeem the voucher, as outlined in the Hofstra Bulletin and Class Schedule. If registration occurs after the initial payment deadline for a semester, the voucher must be submitted at the time of registration. The voucher cannot be used to pay deferred or owed balances. The voucher cannot be refunded for cash. The payment of non-tuition charges and all tuition charges not covered by the voucher are the responsibility of the registrant, and must be paid in accordance with the terms listed in the Hofstra Bulletin and Class Schedule. Pursuant to Hofstra policy, no one can register for classes where there is a hold on a registrant's account.
- 8. No employee or agent of Hofstra shall be deemed an employee or agent of Levittown, and no employees of Levittown shall be deemed an employee or agent of Hofstra, by virtue of this agreement.
- 9. The voucher must be signed by the registrant.
- 10. Vouchers may not be replaced or extended.
- 11. Levittown is bound by the terms of the Student Teaching Handbook(s).
- 12. Levittown must submit a list of teachers' names, paired with their participant-observers' names and hours, by the end of each semester. Hofstra's Office of Field Placement will reconcile its record of students assigned to Levittown with Levittown's record of participating teachers for the purpose of issuing tuition vouchers.
- 13. Levittown may use the **tuition vouchers** to fund professional development programs designed exclusively for Levittown through the Office of Professional Development Services. Levittown will be credited with the

- monetary value of the voucher. The monetary value will be used to offset the cost of the professional development program. Any additional funds required to pay the cost will be paid by Levittown.
- 14. Levittown may not sell tuition vouchers issued to the district nor may they be transferred to non-Levittown individuals.
- 15. Each party shall, to the fullest extent permitted by law and at their own cost and expense, defend, indemnify and hold each other and their respective trustees, directors, employees, servants, representatives and agents harmless from and against any and all claims, losses, damages, expenses (including attorney's fees, witness fees and all court and litigation costs) and liability (including statutory liability), resulting from injury and/or death of any person or damage to or loss of any property arising solely out of its negligent or wrongful act, error or omission or breach of contract, in connection with the operation of this program.

The agreement is effective from September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2017.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Memorandum of Understanding of Terms of Employment ("Memorandum") dated this

day of July, 2015, between the LEVITTOWN UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT and

HELEN FREUND, Secretary to the Superintendent for the District.

WHEREAS, as a confidential employee, Ms. Freund is neither covered by a collective bargaining agreement nor entitled by law to negotiate with the District for her terms and conditions of employment, and the District does not wish to take any action that could be construed as creating any type of binding contract of employment between them; and

WHEREAS, the District nevertheless desires to provide Ms. Freund with an outline of the terms and conditions of employment that it has established for her, so as to avoid any misunderstanding or confusion about those terms and conditions of employment;

NOW THEREFORE, the District, having exercised its discretion to set Ms. Freund's terms and conditions of employment, and having expressed its willingness to codify them pursuant to the caveats set forth above, establishes the terms and conditions of employment of Ms. Freund in her position as Secretary to the Superintendent, as follows:

- 1. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Memorandum will be effective from July 1, 2013 through July 31, 2015.
- 2. <u>Effect</u>. This Memorandum will not be interpreted as creating or constituting a contract or binding agreement of any type. Instead, this Memorandum merely describes the terms and conditions of employment that will be in effect for Ms. Freund during her employment with the District during the period described in paragraph "1."
- 3. <u>Duration</u>. This Memorandum will cover the period July 1, 2013 through and including July 1, 2015.

4. <u>Base Salary</u>. The base salary to be paid to Ms. Freund during the term of this Memorandum will be:

July 1, 2013 – June 30, 2014: \$69,983, plus a \$3,000 confidential stipend

July 1, 2014 – June 30, 2015: \$72,247, plus a \$3,000 confidential stipend

July 1, 2015 – July 31, 2015: \$74,559 (prorated), plus a \$3,000 confidential stipend

5. <u>Terms and Conditions</u>.
