budget adopted as above and the amount which must be raised by taxation \$138,984,161 for School Purposes and \$ 7,445,363 for Library Purposes; total of \$146,429,524 for the Levittown Union Free School District (#5) of the Town of Hempstead, Nassau County, New York for the year 2018-2019 be levied upon the taxable property of said school district as said property has been certified by the Assessor for the school year 2018-2019; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the District Clerk of this School District be and is hereby authorized and directed, pursuant to Section 6-20.0 and amendments thereto of the Nassau County Administrative Code to file a certified copy of these resolutions with the Nassau County

Legislature and the Department of Assessment, Mineola, New York, on or before August 15, 2018."
