Summer Music Program Description:

This program is available to beginning, intermediate and advanced students.

Each student receives two 30 minute lessons per week. Students will be able to participate in small lesson groups for their desired instrument. *Times will be assigned and sent by email by June 15th, 2024.*

Beginning students will get a head start on their instrument for the upcoming school year. This is for students who have 0-2 years of instruction and are not enrolled in a performing ensemble.
