## ALLISON SCIUBBA MEMORIAL AWARD

The Allison Sciubba Memorial Award was established in 1998 in order to commemorate the beautiful life of a Lee Road student who lost her life to cancer at the age of five. Allison loved life and is remembered as a "regular kid" who enjoyed playing on the Lee Road playground with her friends, giggling as she walked through the hallways with her teacher and drawing pictures with her classmates. In the words of (1998) Lee Road Principal Barbara Hornack, "she was a very special person indeed and enriched the lives of all those with whom she came into contact."

AMOUNT: \$500 - payable directly to the winner(s).

NOTE: This project was established and is funded by the Lee Road PTA.

APPLICATIONS: Applications will be made available in the General Douglas MacArthur High School

Guidance Office after January  $1^{st}$ . The final decision on selecting the winner(s) of the award shall be made by the Lee Road PTA Award Selection Committee, which will consist of at least three members of the Lee Road PTA Executive Committee and/or

membership.

CRITERIA: Applicant MUST:

1. Be a graduating senior of General Douglas MacArthur High School;

2. Have attended Lee Road Elementary School;

3. Have resided in the Lee Road Community during elementary school years;

4. Complete attached application and essay question; and

5. Include at least one, but no more than three, letters of recommendation.

**NOTE**: Incomplete applications will not be considered.

ELIGIBILITY: The winner will be chosen based on the above criteria. Special consideration will be

given to essays that show relevance, sincerity, character and personality. Recipient shall be selected without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin or

handicap.

REQUIREMENTS: This award must be used for tuition/educational expenses in any vocational school,

college or other higher learning institute.

NOTE: Award funds that are not used for school fees such as tuition, books or lab

fees should be considered taxable income.

DEADLINE: Must be submitted by April 15<sup>th</sup>.
