Dear Parent/Guardian of 12th Grade Student:

The MacArthur Guidance and Counseling Department is pleased to inform you that we will participate in On-Site Admissions with some of the local colleges in our area this fall. Admissions counselors will be conducting **virtual** interviews to review applications, including transcripts and supporting documents for prospective student applicants. **Application fees will be waived for all students who participate.**

Schools will be conducting virtual interviews on the days listed below:

- Hofstra University Week of Nov. 16th
- NYIT Nov. 23rd
- St. John's Dec. 1st
- LIU Post Dec. 3rd
- Adelphi Dec. 8th
- Molloy Dec. 10th

Please be aware of the following:

- Each school listed above has specific requirements and procedures for the on-site admissions process. <u>This information has been posted in the 12th Grade Guidance</u> <u>Google Classroom under the Classwork tab</u>. Please share this information with your child and review the requirements and deadlines for the schools to which he/she would like to apply.
- An <u>On-Site Transcript Request Form</u> must be submitted to the Guidance Office for each On-Site college to which your child will be applying. This form is available on the 12th Grade Guidance Google Classroom and <u>must</u> be submitted to your child's counselor by the posted deadline.

- Review each school's requirements carefully as some institutions are unable to make decisions during on-site for select majors.
- All on-site admissions virtual appointments will be conducted via zoom after school hours from home. Students who qualify for on-site appointments will be emailed the zoom link information with the appointment day and time in advance either from the guidance office or the individual college. On-Site appointments are set in advance by the college and we are unable to change appointment times.
- Students participating in St. John's On-Site Admissions should be aware that they will be conducting phone meetings rather than utilizing zoom. Students participating in Hofstra's On-Site Admissions will be able to select an appointment throughout the week of Nov. 16th. For Hofstra only, students will be emailed a link to register for their own appointment day and time that week.
- It is the student's responsibility to make sure On-Site applications are complete. Only those students who have completed applications by the deadline will be given a scheduled appointment time to meet with the college admissions representative. We are not able to accommodate on-site requests after the deadline.
- If your child has already applied to one of the above listed schools and believes they would qualify for on-site admissions, please contact your child's counselor directly.
