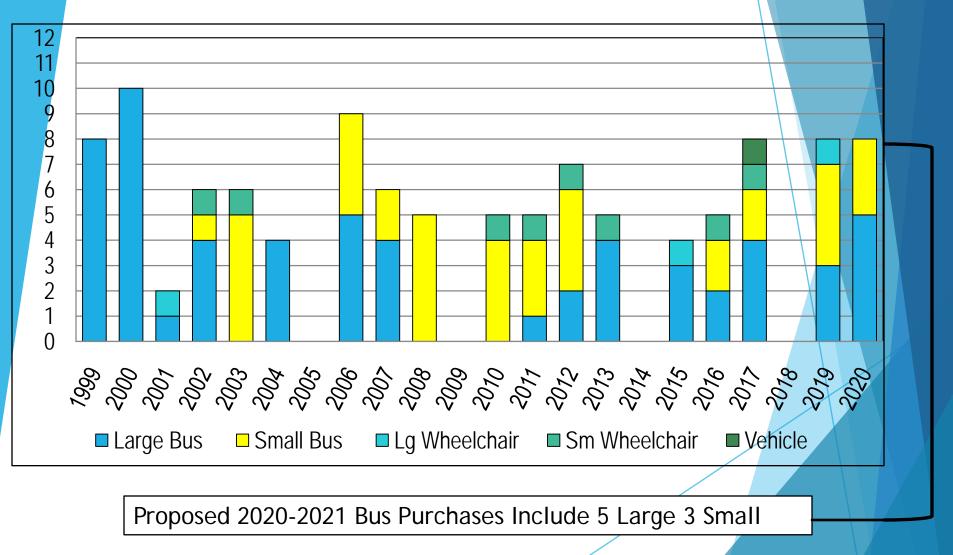

- Initiate reporting of Drug & Alcohol Testing with the NYSDOT (New York State Department of Transportation) for current and incoming employees
