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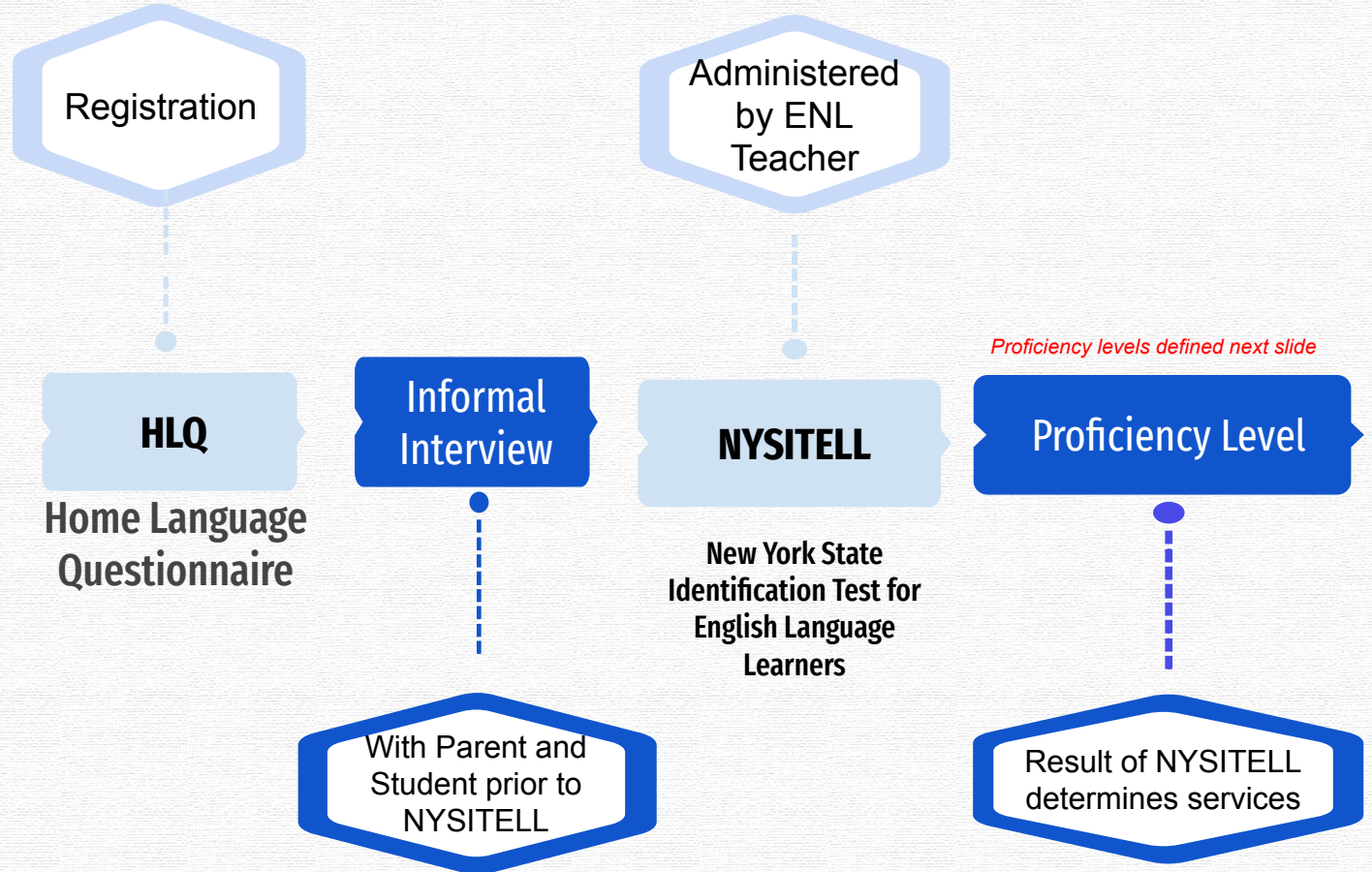

Steps to an ENL Placement





ENTERING	A student at the Entering level has great dependence on supports and structures to advance academic language skills and has not yet met the linguistic demands necessary to demonstrate English language proficiency in a variety of academic contexts (settings).
EMERGING	A student at the Emerging level has some dependence on supports and structures to advance academic language skills and has not yet met the linguistic demands necessary to demonstrate English language proficiency in a variety of academic contexts (settings).
TRANSITIONING	A student at the Transitioning level shows some independence in advancing academic language skills, but has yet to meet the linguistic demands necessary to demonstrate English language proficiency in a variety of academic contexts (settings).
EXPANDING	A student at the Expanding level shows great independence in advancing academic language skills and is approaching the linguistic demands necessary to demonstrate English language proficiency in a variety of academic contexts (settings).
COMMANDING	A student at the Commanding level has met the linguistic demands necessary to demonstrate English language proficiency in a variety of academic contexts (settings). He or she is not an ELL.

- One period per day of Integrated ELA during second half of ELA block during small-group instruction.
- One period per day of Stand Alone ENL Instruction for Entering and Emerging Students

Stand Alone- ENL teacher instructs students in an ENL classroom

Services Provided- Middle School

- One period per day of Integrated ELA for all proficiency levels
- One period per day of Stand Alone ENL Instruction for Entering and Emerging Students

- One period per day of Integrated ELA during ELA class
- One period per day of Stand Alone ENL Instruction for Entering and Emerging Students
- Skills Class is offered to all ELLs for Content Support

Services Provided - High School

- Two periods per day of Stand Alone ENL Instruction for Entering and Emerging Students

- One period per day of Integrated ELA during ELA class
- Two periods per day of Stand Alone ENL Instruction for Entering and Emerging Students
- Integrated instruction in Algebra I, Living Environment, Global I & II, US History as appropriate
- Alternate day Academic Support Class

Integrated- ENL teacher co-teaches in the content area classroom
Stand Alone- ENL teacher instructs students in an ENL classroom

Exiting from ELL Status

The New York State English as a Second Language Achievement Test (NYSESLAT) is administered in May of each academic year.

Students Exit the program if they meet one of the following criteria

- Test Commanding on the NYSESLAT
- Test Expanding on the NYSESLAT + Level 3 or 4 on 3-8 ELA
- Test Expanding on the NYSESLAT + Pass the ELA Regents with a 65 or above

- 5 days per week/4 hours per day/4 weeks
- 77 students attended in the summer of 2023
- Next summer - July 8th - August 2nd
- Transportation included from home school
- No cost to students - grant funded
