

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

SUBJECT: Flag Display

In keeping with the State Education Law and Executive Law, the Board of Education accepts its duty to display the United States flag upon or near each public school building during school hours, weather permitting and such other times as the law may require or the Board may direct.

When ordered by the President, Governor, or local official to commemorate a tragic event or the death of an outstanding individual and when required by law, the United States flag will be flown at half-staff. The Superintendent's approval is required for the flag to be flown at half-staff upon any other occasion.

The United States flag will be displayed in every assembly room (i.e. the Auditorium) including the room where the Board of Education meetings are conducted, as well as displayed in all rooms used for instruction.

Under no circumstances may any flag other than the official flags of the United States, the State of New York or the County of Nassau be flown on District property without the expressed permission of the Board of Education.
