

**SUBJECT: GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

- I. The Board of Education will determine the graduation requirements for the school district in accordance with any specific Regulations of the Commissioner of Education. The Board may establish graduation requirements that exceed the minimum standards set by the Board of Regents. The District will award the appropriate diploma, credential, or both to students as designated by New York State. The Superintendent will develop regulations setting forth the diploma requirements.
- II. Financial Literacy Requirement: In an effort to prepare students for post-secondary life, the Board of Education requires that all students demonstrate competency in financial literacy by earning ½ elective credit in a district approved financial literacy course.
- III. Students in grades 9, 10 and 11 will be fully scheduled. Students in grade 12 will be scheduled for a minimum of 5 periods plus physical education.
