

The Levittown School District is proud to announce another session of an exciting summer program for students in grades 3 through 8 in the upcoming 2025/2026 school year – Adventures in Local History, which explores some of the best local historical locations.

The program will run from Monday, July 14th through Friday, July 18th. Each day students will learn about and discuss a different historical landmark and then embark on field trips to each location. Tentative locations* might include – the Cradle of Aviation, Old Bethpage Restoration, Holocaust Memorial & Tolerance Center of Long Island, Garvies Point, Long Island Museum, Walt Whitman Museum, Smithtown Historical Society, Brookville Environmental Center, Vanderbilt Museum and Planetarium, Huntington Historical Society, Sagamore Hill, and the Whaling Museum and Education Center. At each location students will take part in organized tours and activities related to the specific landmark.

Students will meet at Salk Middle School each day at 9:30 am. Pick up will be at 1:30 pm at Salk Middle School. Students should bring a bagged lunch, water bottle, and a snack each day. If you choose, you may send your child with a small amount of money to purchase souvenirs.

The program will cost \$300. Space is limited to twenty-five students. The registration deadline is June 13th, 2025.
