### Option 1:

#### Lesson Only Groups

- Each student receives on 30 minute lesson twice a week.
- Available for beginning, intermediate and advanced students.

### Option 2:

#### Concert Ensemble Groups

- Each student receives one 90 minute large rehearsal 4 days a week.
- Performance at the end of summer.
- Available ONLY to Intermediate-Advanced students who are already in a performing ensemble during the school year.

### Option 3:

#### Combination of Lessons Only and Concert Ensemble

- Each student receives on 90 minute large rehearsal 4 days a week AND one 30 minute lesson twice a week.
- Performance at the end of the summer.
- Available ONLY to Intermediate-Advanced students who are already in a performing ensemble during the school year.

*If your child wishes to begin or continue studying a musical instrument, Levittown's Summer Music Program might be just the right opportunity! Offering band and orchestra instruction for Grades 3-12, the program provides a head-start for beginners or enrichment for those already involved. Since the program is open to the entire district, students might make new friends with similar interests. For students who are already enrolled in a performing ensemble at school, they will also have the opportunity to showcase what they have learned over the summer at the culminating Summer Concert on August 11th.
