

Dear Parents and Student-Athletes:

Please review the information below regarding the upcoming interscholastic sports seasons. As of November 23rd, 2020, low and moderate risk Winter Sports (bowling, gymnastics, indoor track and field, swimming and diving) have been cleared by the New York State Public High School Athletic Association (NYSPHSAA) to begin on January 4th. NYSPHSAA member schools are not permitted to participate in sports determined to be high risk (basketball, competitive cheer, wrestling) by the New York State Department of Health until authorization is granted by State officials. However, we do expect additional guidance from the State in the coming weeks regarding high risk sports. The expected season dates for Varsity, Junior Varsity, and Modified (Middle School) sports are as follows:

### Varsity and Junior Varsity

### Modified (Middle School)

Winter I	January 4 -- February 5, 2021	Boys Basketball, Girls Volleyball, Competitive Cheer
Winter II	February 8 -- March 19, 2021	Girls Basketball, Boys Volleyball, Wrestling, Bowling
Fall	March 22 -- April 30, 2021	Football, Soccer, Girls Badminton, Cross Country, Fall Cheer
Spring	May 3 -- June 11, 2021	Baseball, Softball, Lacrosse, Track

Due to rescheduling, the **Fall Season will take place between the Winter and Spring Seasons** this year. Additionally, please take note of the following information and policies regarding the upcoming athletic seasons:

- There has been **NO** waiver of physical exam requirements by the New York State Education Department. All student athletes must have a current physical on file in order to participate in interscholastic athletics. Information on School Doctor dates will be disseminated as soon as it is available.
- All students must register on FamilyID in order to be eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics. Links to FamilyID can be found on each school's website.
- A policy regarding spectator attendance at contests will be announced as soon as it is available..
