## Here's the Latest and **Greatest in Levittown**


Over the summer, several capital projects were completed throughout the district. At five of our elementary schools – Abbey Lane, Lee Road, East Broadway, Gardiners Avenue, and Summit Lane – projects included upgrades to fire alarms, classroom public announcement systems and security systems. # LEVITTOWN MIDDLE SCHOOLS SHINE WITH NATIONAL AND STATE HONORS

Levittown's two middle schools, Wisdom Lane and Jonas E. Salk, have each earned prestigious honors that reflect their excellence in middle level education and dedication to student growth.

Wisdom Lane Middle School has earned a 2025 School of Distinction from the Association for Middle Level Education (AMLE), a national designation celebrating schools that exemplify best practices in middle level education. The honor followed a rigorous review process that included a comprehensive self-assessment, continuous improvement planning and interviews with staff, students, and

Levittown is proud to be only the fourth district on Long Island to receive an AMLE national distinction and one of just three in New York State recognized this year. Wisdom Lane Principal John Avena credited the accomplishment to the school's "inclusive and supportive community," noting that the honor reflects the dedication of faculty and staff who nurture both academic and socialemotional growth in students.

Jonas E. Salk Middle School has also been recognized for its continued excellence. In 2023, Salk earned redesignation as an Essential Elements School to Watch by the New York

State Education Department, and in 2025, it was named a State School of Character by Character.org. The Essential Elements program recognizes middle schools that demonstrate academic excellence, developmental responsiveness and a strong commitment to continuous growth. The School of Character distinction, awarded to only six New York schools this year, honors Salk's strong culture of caring and inclusivity.

Barbara Monteiro-Grady, a Salk school psychologist who played an instrumental role in the application process, attributed the recognition to the school's RISE program, which teaches students core values that strengthen behavior, academics and social learning. "This recognition reflects our commitment to fostering an environment in which everyone belongs," said Salk Principal John Zampaglione.

Guided by the district's motto, #SuccessAtLPS, Levittown's middle schoolers pursue academic excellence while growing socially and emotionally through academics, arts, athletics, and clubs. ### **Esports Brings the Excitement**

Both Wisdom Lane and Salk are home to robust esports programs, connecting young gamers to their deep passion. As a team playing side by side, both esports teams practice camaraderie and coordination to achieve a common goal. The teams face off against other schools in esports competitions, including a local Super Smash Bros. tournament against fellow middle schools.





### Spreading the Success

Wisdom Lane and Salk show support for their local communities throughout the year. At Wisdom Lane, the Jan Friedman Food Pantry stays stocked year-round thanks to various collection drives organized by students. The goods collected benefit local families in need. During the holiday season, Salk joined with General Douglas MacArthur High School to run a massively successful toy drive for Columbia University Irving Medical Center, with donations hand delivered to the hospital.







Wisdom and Salk's extracurricular activities are constantly expanding and evolving to meet the interests and needs of all students. Both middle schools are home to student-led clubs that break down into niche passions, like the Anime, Fishing or Science clubs. In the Multicultural Club, students dive into international cultures by creating inspired works of art – such as Cuban yarn dolls – and trying out new foods. Tranquil sessions of yoga and meditation can be found in the Mindfulness and Meditation Club, while teamwork and strategic thinking are reinforced in the Dungeons and Dragons Club.
