**Treasurer's Report: General Fund:** Opening (03/22/10-04/15/10) \$ 8,760.50, Closing (03/22/10-04/15/10)\$8,760.50 Scholarship: Opening (03/22/10-04/15/10)\$11,768.71, Closing (02/25/10-03/22/10)\$11,768.71. *No changes to the Treasurer's Report it is filed for audit.* Note: There was a typographical error on last month's report; closing amount on Scholarship Fund should have read \$11,768.71. Report on file.

**Superintendent's Report:** Dr. H. Sirois, Superintendent. Police have taken action with regards to the Division Ave. fire; some 6<sup>th</sup> graders from Wisdom Lane were responsible. Dr. Sirois discussed the budget: budget flyers are not being mailed out – hard copies are available at various locations around town, information can be found on District website. 2010-2011 Proposed budget has a proper fund balance, average is below 4% for the 6<sup>th</sup> year in a row, state aide shortfalls continue to be concern however reserves/fund balance enable District to monitor and keep lax levy low. Contingency budget would mean 0% increase but would require reduction of \$11 million and then 23% increase in 2011-2012 to restore programs. Discussion of 2010-2011 reductions: Special Education: while all IEPs would be followed related services and out of district students would be curtailed. Enrichment: restructuring across the grades. Page 7 of Budget has list of items that would be cut totaling \$12million. They are ranked from largest to smallest amount of money. Discussion and questions about budget. Mr. Pappas spoke of the importance of budget passing – a lot of misinformation in the community – important we are all on the "same page". *Motion:* We, as a Council, support the school district budget. *1 abstention, Remainder in favor, Motion passes*.
