Dear Parents and Guardians of 10th and 11th grade students:

Division Avenue High School will be administering the PSAT/NMSQT exam at the high school on **Saturday, October 11th**. The PSAT/NMSQT exam is a standardized test that provides firsthand practice for the SAT Reasoning test. It also gives 11th grade students a chance to enter the National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) scholarship programs. The exam assesses a student's readiness for college and is composed of three sections: writing, critical reading and mathematics. **Students must arrive at 7:30am. The test begins at 8:00am and ends at approximately 12:00pm.**

Payment for the PSAT will be through MySchoolBucks from September 9 to September 19, with a cost of \$31.25. After making the payment, students must complete the registration form and submit it to the Guidance Office by **September 22**. Please note that Friday, September 19 is a firm deadline—no payments will be accepted after this date. Juniors who qualified for the NYS Free or Reduced Lunch Program during the 2024–2025 school year may be eligible for a fee waiver and should contact the Guidance secretaries as soon as possible.

We recommend that all 11th grade students take advantage of this opportunity. The PSAT is a qualifying test that 11th graders must take to enter the National Merit Scholarship Corporation competitions for college scholarships that will be awarded during senior year.

It is recommended that 10th grade students choosing to take the PSAT this year be enrolled in an accelerated math class, as the PSAT covers Geometry, which many 10th graders have not yet completed. 10th grade students who opt to take the PSAT this year should take it again in the 11th grade for scholarship opportunities.

Please be advised that the PSAT is a fully digital test and all students must bring their fully charged Chromebooks to the exam.
