Dear Parents and Guardians of 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students:

Division Avenue High School will be administering the PSAT/NMSQT exam at the high school on **Saturday, October 11th.** The PSAT/NMSQT exam is a standardized test that provides firsthand practice for the SAT Reasoning test. It also gives 11<sup>th</sup> grade students a chance to enter the National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) scholarship programs. The exam assesses a student's readiness for college and is composed of three sections: writing, critical reading and mathematics. **Students must arrive at 7:30am. The test begins at 8:00am and ends at approximately 12:00pm.** 

Payment for the PSAT will be through MySchoolBucks from September 9 to September 19, with a cost of \$31.25. After making the payment, students must complete the registration form and submit it to the Guidance Office by September 22. Please note that Friday, September 19 is a firm deadline—no payments will be accepted after this date. Juniors who qualified for the NYS Free or Reduced Lunch Program during the 2024–2025 school year may be eligible for a fee waiver and should contact the Guidance secretaries as soon as possible.

We recommend that all  $11^{th}$  grade students take advantage of this opportunity. The PSAT is a qualifying test that  $11^{th}$  graders must take to enter the National Merit Scholarship Corporation competitions for college scholarships that will be awarded during senior year.

It is recommended that  $10^{th}$  grade students choosing to take the PSAT this year be enrolled in an accelerated math class, as the PSAT covers Geometry, which many  $10^{th}$  graders have not yet completed.  $10^{th}$  grade students who opt to take the PSAT this year should take it again in the  $11^{th}$  grade for scholarship opportunities.

Please be advised that the PSAT is a fully digital test and all students must bring their fully charged Chromebooks to the exam.
