SCHOLARSHIP - **Jenkins Memorial Scholarship for Teacher Education**
CRITERIA - Seniors who plan to attend a SUNY college, university, or community college (before transferring to a SUNY school) in order to prepare for a teaching career.
DEADLINE - Application must be returned to Guidance by **December 9, 2025**

CRITERIA - Seniors will be evaluated based on leadership potential, academic performance, demonstration to community service and financial need.

SCHOLARSHIP - **The NHS Scholarship**
CRITERIA - Seniors must be NHS members in good standing of an affiliated NHS chapter. Student membership must be verified before the application can be started – allow time for this.
DEADLINE - Submitted electronically by **November 24, 2025** (5:00 PM EST)

SCHOLARSHIP - **Ron Brown Scholar Program**
CRITERIA - Seniors must be African American and demonstrate academic excellence, leadership ability, participation in community service and financial need.
DEADLINE - Submitted electronically by **December 1, 2025**

SCHOLARSHIP - **LIASCD Ira Schwartz Scholarship**
CRITERIA - Seniors who plan to attend college in the fall, must have at least an 85 GPA and demonstrate financial need. Students must submit a personal narrative describing a demonstrated ability to overcome adversity.
DEADLINE - Return to Guidance by **December 15, 2025** *(only two applications allowed per district)*

SCHOLARSHIP - **Island Federal Credit Union Scholarships**
CRITERIA - Seniors must have an Island Federal checking account and debit card in order to enter a scholarship drawing.

SCHOLARSHIP - **Dr. Jong Pil Lee Memorial Scholarship**
CRITERIA - African American, Native American and/or Hispanic seniors who have at least a “B” average and are planning to major in mathematics.
