Here's how you can join in. **PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!**

1. Every participant must electronically submit their PTA Talent Show Registration / Permission Slip Google Form by **Monday, March 1<sup>st</sup>** (this will be sent out to parents/guardians via Connect-Ed email/text, posted on your child's Google Classroom, and posted on the building's website).
2. **Please be aware that students must fully prepare their acts. Acts must be filmed and emailed to Dr. Giusto or attached as an assignment in the Talent Show Google Classroom by the deadlines established.** Be ready to dazzle us with your talents!
3. You must include a copy of any song lyrics used when you submit your Registration Form. ALL music must be "Disney G Rated" or "Student Cut Versions". This is known as the "Squeaky Clean" version.
4. All performances must be in good taste and appropriate. The PTA Talent Show Committee Members and Gardiners Avenue Administrative Staff have the final decision to decline song lyrics/content/acts that are deemed inappropriate.
5. Students may only submit 1 act for the show. (For instance, if you are performing a solo act, you can't also submit a group act). Each act should be approximately 3-5 minutes long (with a max time limit of 5 minutes).
6. Out of respect to all participating, all students and their families should refrain from sharing portions of the final show on social media.
