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**Ms. Boyd's class earned extra art for I-Ready! We drew our self portraits and had so much fun adding fun and silly details!**



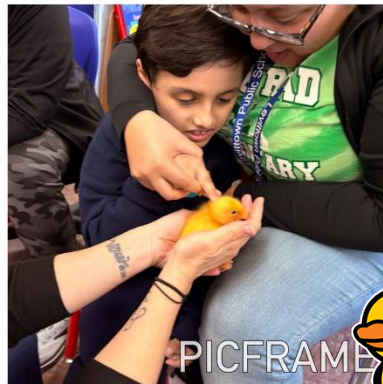

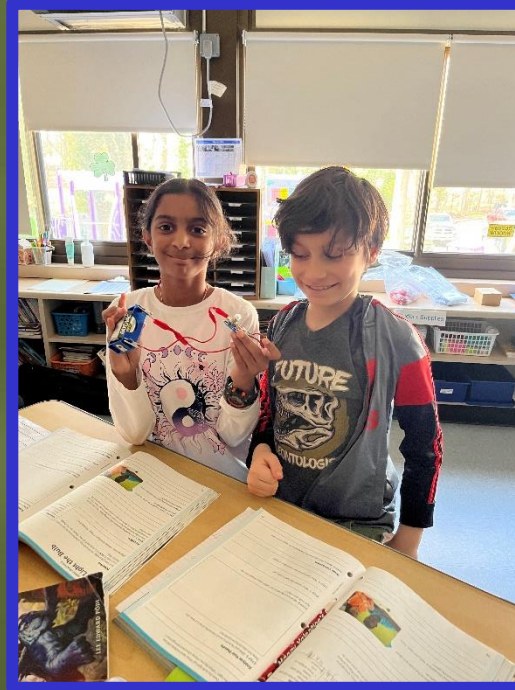
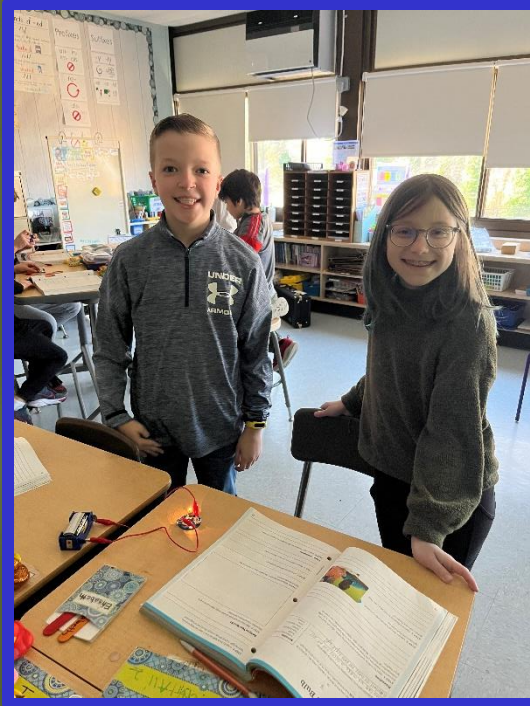


**Ms. Dunbar's class had a blast at the Outdoor Learning Center! They built wind turbines, explored the greenhouse, and watched the fish in the pond!**



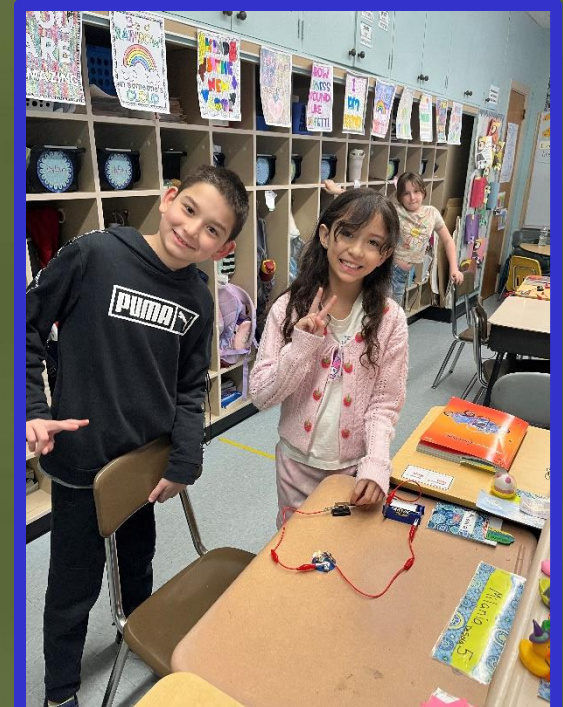
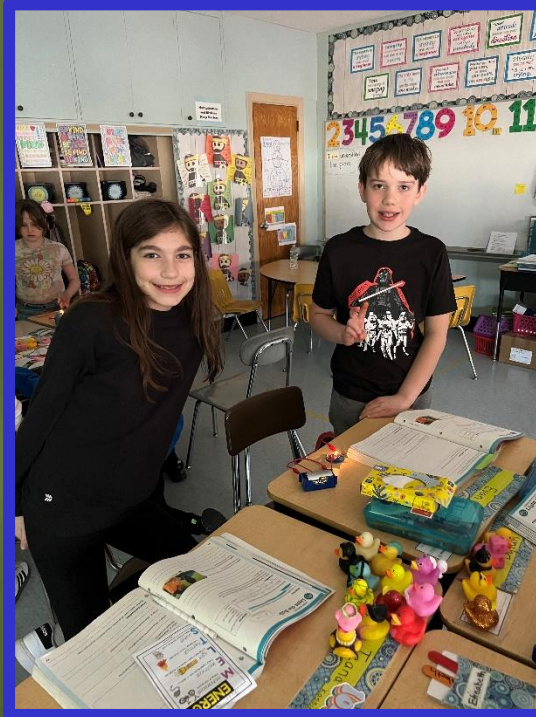
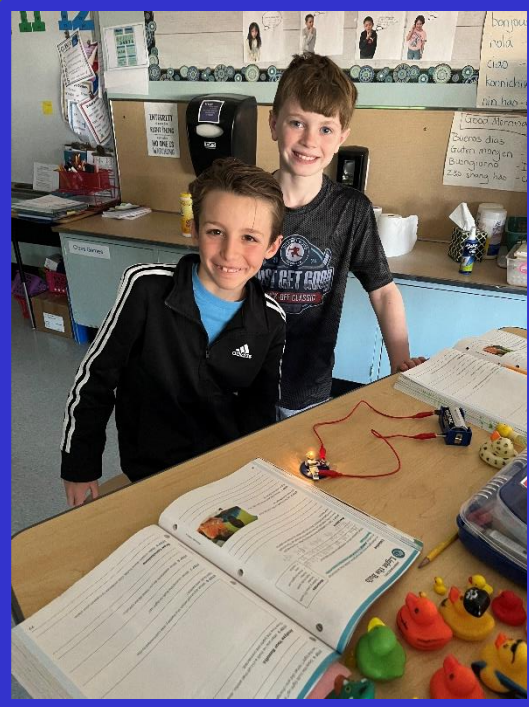
