We have implemented a Student Learning Objective (SLO) for grades K-3 which is a short pre-assessment of what the children should learn by the end of the year. Grades 2 thorugh 5 will have a new report card system. There will be only three marking periods, December, March and June. At Back to School Night, you will receive more information regarding report cards and grading. Parent teacher conferences will be taking place on October 25 and 29th. In closing, I am looking forward to a great year. Welcome PTA Presidents. I know you will make it a great year for the children. Remember, my door is always open. Thank you!
